

DON HARTMAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Don Hartman North East Sportsplex is the result of a vision, a dream and the persevering desire of a small group of Properties Sports Association (PSA) hockey organizers and parents in the late 1970's and the early 1980's to build a sports facility in the North East Properties, and to provide a home for PSA hockey. This award was established in 1982 in memory of Don Hartman, Alderman and supporter of the dream for this facility.

- DONOR:** Don Hartman North East Sportsplex Society
- WHERE TENABLE:** Calgary Board of Education and Calgary Catholic School District
- FIELD OF STUDY:** Unrestricted
- VALUE:** \$500
- NUMBER:** Two (Preference for 1 CBE & 1 CSSD)
- ELIGIBILITY:** Open to students registered in grade 12 who are completing the requirements of a high school diploma. Applicant must have a minimum 65% GPA in their five best Grade 12 subjects.
- Applicants must currently **reside** in the area served by the Don Hartman North East Sportsplex bounded by the area north of 16th Avenue NE to the Calgary city limits, from Barlow Trail to 84th Street NE. If no qualified applicants meet the above residing criteria then the award will open up to any qualified candidate residing in the NE quadrant of Calgary.
- Applicants must have demonstrated positive citizenship and athletic qualities as revealed by participation in activities for the school and/or community (i.e. athletics, volunteerism, non-academic activities and clubs).
- APPLY:** Applicants should complete the EducationMatters **General Application for Awards**. Complete application packages should be submitted to the Scholarship Coordinator at the Applicant's high school.
- SELECTION & PAYMENT:** Recipients are selected in September. To claim the award, within one (1) year of high school graduation the recipient must be registered in an eligible program of post-secondary study of at least two years duration. Payments are made to the post-secondary institutions.
- DEADLINE:** Normally **May 30** to the Scholarship Coordinator at the Applicant's high school. Applicants should check with their Guidance office for application deadlines in their school.
