

DORIS DONALD MEMORIAL BURSARY IN FINE ARTS

This award was established in 1982 through the Alberta Child Reach Society in memory of Doris Donald. The purpose of the award is to assist students who could not afford class fees and/or materials without financial help.

- WHERE TENABLE:** Calgary Board of Education
- FIELD OF STUDY:** Music, Art, Drama and Dance
- VALUE:** \$300
- NUMBER:** One
- ELIGIBILITY:** Open to students registered in grades 10, 11 and 12 who are completing the requirements of a high school diploma. Applicants must have demonstrated artistic ability and a desire to develop these skills and demonstrated financial need.
- Applicants must submit an original or copy of a creative work or an original essay outlining the area of fine arts they are pursuing. The essay must be no more than 500 words in length (one page, typed or printed).
- APPLY:** Applicants should complete the EducationMatters **General Application for Awards**. Complete application packages should be submitted to the Scholarship Coordinator at the Applicant's high school.
- SELECTION & PAYMENT:** Recipients are selected in August. Payment of award will be made directly to student.
- DEADLINE:** Normally **May 30** to the Scholarship Coordinator at the Applicant's high school. Applicants should check with their Guidance office for application deadlines in their school.
