

EducationMatters CAREER & TECHNOLOGY STUDIES (CTS) SCHOLARSHIP

CTS Scholarships are to encourage able and deserving students to continue beyond the senior high school level with further education or training. This scholarship recognizes the top CTS students within the Calgary Board of Education.

WHERE TENABLE: Calgary Board of Education

FIELD OF STUDY: Unrestricted

VALUE: \$1,000

NUMBER: Two

ELIGIBILITY: Open to students registered in grade 12 who are completing the requirements of a high school diploma. Applicants must have successfully completed Career and Technology Studies courses or have successfully completed 1,000 hours towards their apprenticeship.

Students must have attended two full years of senior high school in the Calgary Board of Education system and must be qualified for an Alberta High School Diploma.

Applicants must have 20 or more credits in Career and Technology Studies (these credits may include Career Transition credits), with 5 credits at the Advanced Level (30). The student must have a 75% average or better in the 20 credits.

APPLY: Applicants should complete the EducationMatters **General Application for Awards**. Complete application packages should be submitted to the Scholarship Coordinator at the Applicant's high school.

SELECTION & PAYMENT: Recipients are selected in September. To claim the award, within two (2) years of high school graduation the recipient must be registered full-time in an eligible program of at least (1) one year duration, including vocational, technical or post-secondary institutions. Payments are made to the post-secondary institutions.

DEADLINE: **Normally May 30** to the Scholarship Coordinator at the Applicant's high school. Applicants should check with their Guidance office for application deadlines in their school.
