

ENMAX ENVIRONMENTAL LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP

Established in 2005 by ENMAX Energy Corporation, this award is intended to provide support to students pursuing post-secondary studies that lead to an environment-related career.

- DONOR:** ENMAX Energy Corporation
- WHERE TENABLE:** Calgary Board of Education
- FIELD OF STUDY:** Any field of study that leads to an environment-related career
- VALUE:** \$2,000
- NUMBER:** Three
- ELIGIBILITY:** Open to students registered in grade 12 who are completing the requirements of a high school diploma. Applicants must have demonstrated academic progress and have a minimum 65% GPA in grade 12. Applicants must have demonstrated outstanding environmental leadership and citizenship qualities as revealed by the participation in non-academic activities for the school and community throughout high school.
- Applicants are required to submit an original essay on how the student plans to show environmental leadership in the future by applying their post secondary studies. The essay will be no more than 500 words in length (one page, typed or printed). Two letters of recommendation are required. Letters may be provided by two school officials or a school official and a community leader representing a community-based organization, and demonstrate the applicant's environmental leadership and citizenship.
- APPLY:** Applicants should complete the EducationMatters **General Application for Awards**. Complete application packages should be submitted to the Scholarship Coordinator at the Applicant's high school.
- SELECTION & PAYMENT:** Recipients are selected in September. To claim the award, within fifteen (15) months of high school graduation the recipient must be registered in an eligible program of post-secondary study of at least two years duration leading to a degree or diploma in a field that leads to an environment-related career. Payments will be made to the post-secondary institutions.
- DEADLINE:** Normally **May 30** to the Scholarship Coordinator at the Applicant's high school. Applicants should check with their Guidance office for application deadlines in their school.
