

MARJORIE TAYLOR MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Bow Valley Music Club is a not-for-profit society providing an annual series of live musical concerts primarily in the folk music style. Marjorie Taylor was a founding member and hard-working active volunteer for the Club until her passing in 1999. The members of the Bow Valley Music Club are very proud to offer this award to commemorate Marjorie Taylor's significant contribution to the enhancement of live music performance in the city of Calgary. The award is intended to assist students in furthering their education in music study at the post-secondary level.

DONOR: Bow Valley Music Club

WHERE TENABLE: Calgary Board of Education and Calgary Separate School District

FIELD OF STUDY: Unrestricted

VALUE: \$1,000

NUMBER: Two

ELIGIBILITY: Open to students registered in grade 12 who are completing the requirements of a high school diploma. Applicants must have demonstrated interest and ability in the study of music in high school, evidenced through participation in structured music school study programs, including extracurricular musical activities.

Applicants must submit an original essay describing their involvement in musical performance, areas of current study, and their planned future music study program. The essay must be no more than 500 words in length (one page, typed or printed).

Preference will be given to students who are planning post-secondary studies in acoustic stringed instruments, keyboard or voice.

Selection will be based on the applicant's demonstrated involvement in music study and the essay.

APPLY: Applicants should complete the EducationMatters **General Application for Awards**. Complete application packages should be submitted to the Scholarship Coordinator at the Applicant's high school.

SELECTION & PAYMENT: Recipients are selected in September. To claim the award, within two (2) years of notification of award the recipient must be registered in an eligible program of post-secondary study of at least two years duration. Payments will be made to the post-secondary institutions.

DEADLINE: Normally **May 30** to the Scholarship Coordinator at the Applicant's high school. Applicants should check with their Guidance office for application deadlines in their school.
