

MALWYN JONES MEMORIAL AWARD

- DONOR:** Bowness Lions Club
- WHERE TENABLE:** Bowness High School
- FIELD OF STUDY:** Unrestricted
- VALUE:** \$2,000
- NUMBER:** Two, with a preference for one male and one female
- ELIGIBILITY:** Open to students in Grade 12 who are enrolled in an appropriate program of studies at Bowness High School and successfully graduate from the high school program. Applicants must have attained a GPA of not less than 65% during their final year of high school.
- Applicants must display a positive attitude towards their studies and the school community, and applicants must demonstrate their commitments to future studies at post-secondary educational institutions. Applicants must demonstrate financial need and be a resident of Calgary, Alberta.
- The recipients of these awards must be pursuing studies in any field of interest chosen by the recipient in a program of studies at either Mount Royal University Calgary or the Southern Alberta Institute of Technology Calgary.
- APPLY:** Applicants should complete the **Green & Gold Legacy Fund Application form**. Complete application packages should be submitted to the Scholarship Coordinator at the Applicant's high school.
- SELECTION & PAYMENT:** School-specific. Recipients will be notified by September. To claim the award, within fifteen (15) months of high school graduation the recipient must be registered in an eligible program of post-secondary study of at least two years duration. Payments will be made to the post-secondary institutions.
- DEADLINE:** Normally **May 30** to the Scholarship Coordinator at the Applicant's high school. Applicants should check with their Guidance office for application deadlines in their school.

The Green and Gold Scholarships were established in 2002 by Bowness High School. The purpose of the award is to provide monetary incentive for students pursuing post-secondary studies.

Eligibility Criteria

The successful recipient will:

- 1. Demonstrate outstanding ability, achievement, leadership and citizenship throughout Grades 10, 11 and 12.*
- 2. Demonstrate financial need and be a resident of Calgary, Alberta.*
- 3. Qualify for an Alberta High School Diploma with a Grade 12 average of 65% or better in five courses, at least three of which must be 30-level academic courses.*
- 4. Recipient must be pursuing studies in any field of interest chosen by the recipient in a program of studies at either Mount Royal University Calgary or the Southern Alberta Institute of Technology Calgary.*

Scholarships will be awarded after the recipient submits proof of enrolment in an eligible program of post-secondary study of at least two years of duration. The award recipient has 15 months from the day of finishing grade 12 to claim their scholarship.
