Applicants must have demonstrated academic progress in grade 12 and marks sufficient for entrance to a post-secondary area of study.</p> <p>The recipient must be registered in an eligible program of study in Canada of at least two year's duration leading to a degree or diploma.</p>
APPLY:	<p>Applicants should complete the Louise Dean Student Application Form. Complete application packages should be submitted to the Scholarship Coordinator at Louise Dean school.</p>
SELECTION & PAYMENT:	<p>School-specific. Recipients will be notified by September. Payment will be made to the post-secondary institution.</p>
DEADLINE:	<p>Normally May 30 to the Scholarship Coordinator at the Applicant's high school. Applicants should check with their Guidance office for application deadlines in their school.</p>
