

## **KAFE12 BURSARY**

*This award was established in 2010 from the Jim Gray Safer Calgary Awards - Community Award prize. The purpose of the bursary is to provide an incentive for students who might otherwise be discouraged by reason of financial need to pursue post-secondary education.*

- DONOR:** Jim Gray Safer Calgary Awards
- WHERE TENABLE:** Calgary Board of Education and Calgary Catholic School District
- FIELD OF STUDY:** Unrestricted
- VALUE:** \$1,000
- NUMBER:** One
- ELIGIBILITY:** Open to students registered in grade 12 who are completing the requirements of a high school graduation. Applicants must have demonstrated academic progress and have a minimum 65% GPA in grade 12; 300 word essay describing challenges overcome to complete school; and demonstrated financial need.
- Selection will be based primarily on the essay, financial need, with consideration of academic merit.
- APPLY:** Applicants should complete the EducationMatters **General Application for Awards**. Complete application packages should be submitted to the Scholarship Coordinator at the Applicant's high school.
- SELECTION & PAYMENT:** Recipients are selected in September. To claim the award within (1) one year of high school graduation the recipient must be registered full-time in an eligible program of post-secondary study of at least one year's duration, or an eligible skilled trades or apprenticeship program leading to a degree, diploma or certificate. Payments will be made to the post-secondary institutions.
- DEADLINE:** Normally **May 30** to the Scholarship Coordinator at the Applicant's high school. Applicants should check with their Guidance office for application deadlines in their school.
