

ENMAX TRADES SCHOLARSHIP

Established in 2005 by ENMAX Energy Corporation, this award is intended to provide support to students pursuing Trades related studies.

- DONOR:** ENMAX Energy Corporation
- WHERE TENABLE:** Calgary Board of Education
- FIELD OF STUDY:** Trades related studies
- VALUE:** \$2,000
- NUMBER:** Two
- ELIGIBILITY:** Open to students registered in grade 12 who are completing the requirements of a high school diploma. Applicants must have demonstrated academic progress and have a minimum 60% GPA in grade 12. Applicants must have demonstrated outstanding citizenship qualities as revealed by the participation in non-academic activities for the school and community throughout high school.
- Two letters of recommendation are required. Letters may be provided by two school officials or a school official and a community leader representing a community-based organization, demonstrating the applicant's outstanding citizenship.
- APPLY:** Applicants should complete the EducationMatters **General Application for Awards**. Complete application packages should be submitted to the Scholarship Coordinator at the Applicant's high school.
- SELECTION & PAYMENT:** Recipients are selected in September. To claim the award, within fifteen (15) months of high school graduation the recipient must be registered in an eligible program of post-secondary study of skilled trades or apprenticeships. Payments will be made to the post-secondary institutions.
- DEADLINE:** Normally **May 30** to the Scholarship Coordinator at the Applicant's high school. Applicants should check with their Guidance office for application deadlines in their school.
