<b>NUMBER:</b>	One
<b>ELIGIBILITY:</b>	<p>Open to students registered in Grade 12 at Crescent Heights High School who are completing the requirements of a high school diploma.</p> <p>Applicants must have taken or currently be taking Physical Education 30, be involved in school activities and demonstrate evidence of being a good citizen. Student's mark/standing in Physical Education will be the primary consideration in determining the recipient.</p> <p>Preference will be given to students who plan to pursue post-secondary studies related to Physical Education.</p> <p>Selection will be based on Physical 30 Education marks and citizenship qualities as demonstrated through the student's contribution to the school through extra-curricular activities.</p> <p>Recipients must not have received more than \$500 in other school-based awards specific for Crescent Heights students.</p>
<b>APPLY:</b>	Online application available at <a href="http://www.educationmatters.ca">www.educationmatters.ca</a> . Applicants should check with their guidance office for more information and are encouraged to discuss their application with the Scholarship Coordinator at their high school.
<b>SELECTION AND PAYMENT:</b>	Selection will be made by a selection committee at Crescent Heights High School, including a representative from EducationMatters. To claim the award, within two (2) years of notification of award, the recipient must be registered in an eligible program of study at a Canadian University. Payments are made to the post-secondary institution.
<b>DEADLINE:</b>	<b>May 30</b>
