SELECTION & PAYMENT:	Selection will be made by staff at Lester B. Pearson High School, including a representative of EducationMatters and recipients will be notified by fall. To claim the award, within six (6) months of notification of award, the recipient must be registered in an eligible program of four years duration at a Canadian degree granting institution. Payments are made to the post-secondary institution upon proof of enrolment and confirmation of program of study.
