ELIGIBILITY:	Open to students registered in grade 12 who are completing the requirements of a high school diploma. Applicants must have demonstrated academic progress and show determination toward further education in a program of at least two years duration, including vocational, technical or post-secondary institution. The recipient must be registered in an eligible program of study within one year of receiving the award.
NOMINATION PROCESS:	Recommended by principal.
APPLY:	Online application available at www.educationmatters.ca . Applicants should check with their guidance office for more information and are encouraged to discuss their application with the Scholarship Coordinator at their high school.
SELECTION & PAYMENT:	To be eligible, the student must demonstrate both academic success and financial need. Payment is issued to the post-secondary institution.
