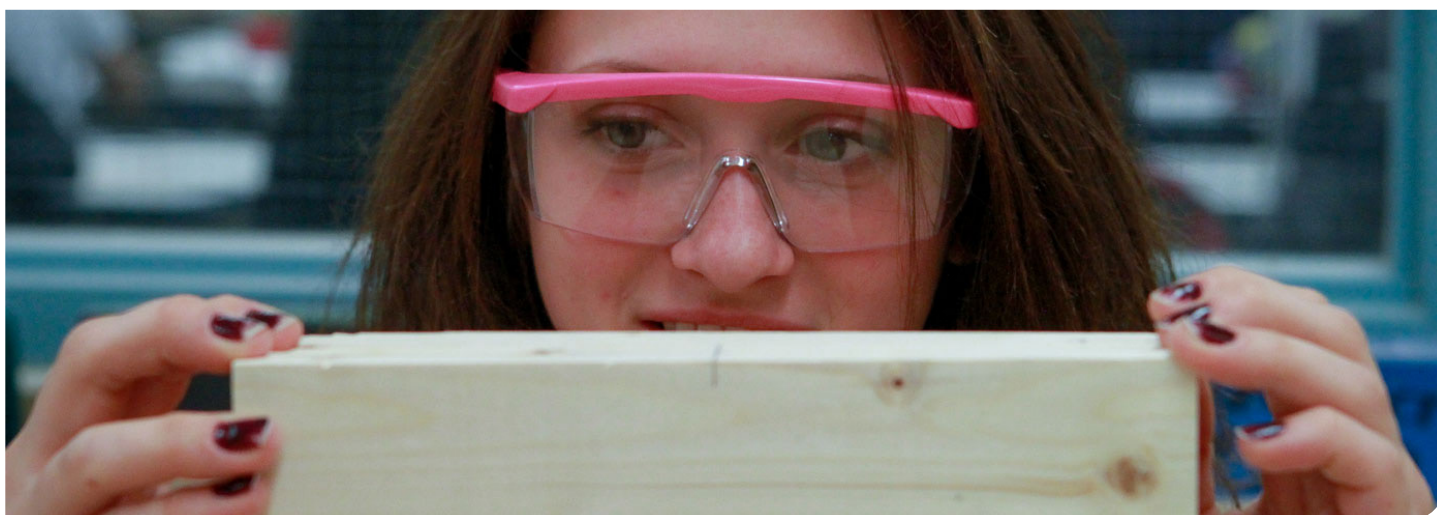

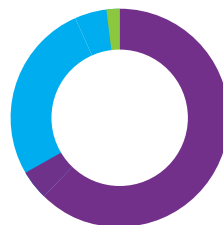

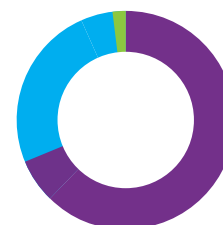


Grants by

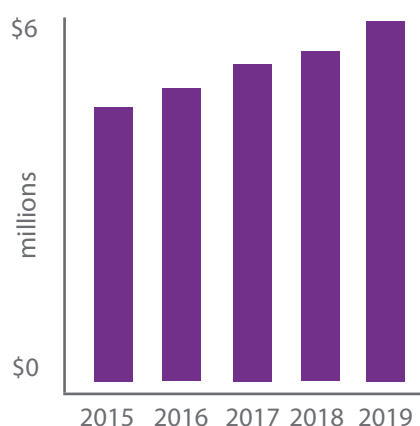
