ELIGIBILITY:	<p>Open to students registered in grade 12 who are completing the requirements of a high school diploma.</p> <p>Applicants are required to submit an original essay of three paragraphs and 500 words outlining:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">a) Who Are You? Tell us about yourself and why health and nutrition is important to you.b) What is Your Passion? Tell us how your passion relates to health and nutrition.c) What is Your Plan? If you pursue this course of study, tell us how it will make a difference in your life and in the lives of others. <p>Selection will be based on the essay.</p>
APPLY:	Applicants should complete the EducationMatters General Application #2 – May 30 Deadline . Complete application packages should be submitted to the Scholarship Coordinator at the applicant's high school.
SELECTION & PAYMENT:	Recipients are selected by September. To claim the award, within two (2) years of notification of award the recipient must be registered in an eligible program of post-secondary study. Payments will be made to the post-secondary institutions.
DEADLINE:	Normally May 30 to the Scholarship Coordinator at the applicant's high school. Applicants should check with their Guidance office for application deadlines in their school.
